### Washability Test (ASTM D 4828)

Ceilings installed in laboratories, clean rooms, food preparation areas, and other sanitary applications are required to meet washability standards. The Washability Test evaluates a ceiling's ability to withstand washing.

- The test uses the washing (or scrubbing) action of a sponge.
- It measures a ceiling surface's resistance to repeated wash cycles.
- Ratings are based on either the ability of the surface to withstand up to 150 wash cycles without breakthrough or the extent of abrasion.
