In 1961 we opened an Australian office, and in 1969 George Jennings drove to a brand new factory to produce the first locally made Armstrong flooring.

George was our first General Manager, responsible for commissioning our manufacturing facilities at Braeside in Victoria, introducing new technologies and employing and training a new workforce.

This was a golden era of economic growth, and today, whilst many manufacturing enterprises have faltered, Armstrong is still the only Australian manufacturer of resilient vinyl sheet and tile.

Since 1969 our two Australian factories have produced Over 100 million square metres of flooring material; our Australian made products are exported to over 20 countries; our workforce numbers over 200; our environmental initiatives have won the National Greenhouse Challenge Plus awards for reduction in CO<sub>2</sub> emissions, the Keep Australia Beautiful awards and we have twice been a finalist in the savewater awards®.

True to the principles of Thomas Armstrong our products are renowned for their integrity and durability and the industry's most comprehensive customer service and warranties.
